Mrs. Romero reported on the Brawley Union High School District's Consolidated Application. Parents reviewed the current application and were asked to offer advice and suggestions. Input from the parents indicated they agreed with submitting the application. Mr. Munguia motioned to approve the Consolidated Application and was seconded by Mr. Padilla.

**Distance Learning**

In view of the 2020-2021 upcoming school year distance learning model, parents were encouraged to comment on what they believe works well, what needs improvement and voice their concerns. Mrs. Veronica Sandoval mentioned that she was pleased with the teacher's effort in reaching out to students by setting up parent/student conferences and making sure students had all the necessary school supplies. Mrs. Kenia Galvez said that an advantage was that every student had a chromebook available. She noticed that teachers were on top of students making sure they turned in quality work and on time. Teachers offered valuable feedback on student work. She understands that it was a pilot program, but her son didn't have trouble adjusting to it. In regards to areas that need improvement, Mrs. Galvez mentioned that her son decided to drop advanced courses since he is afraid that distance learning will make it too complicated and may fail. She feels that having students learning from home may pose a challenge since they require physical activity and socialization. Mrs. Galvez believes that group video conferences may help students with this issue. Mr. Munguia informed parents that next week counselors will be speaking to students to address these concerns. Also, the school will be sending out notifications starting with the freshmen class to pick up their chromebook and school supplies. The goal is for each student to have their own chromebook. Brawley High School is looking into various teaching models, one may be offering only three courses at a time in order for students to feel comfortable and not overwhelmed by juggling six classes at a time. Further information will be provided to parents as decisions are being made. Mr. Munguia mentioned that it is necessary for some students to change their mentality and embrace this new teaching model if they want to be successful.
