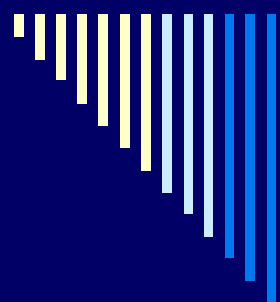

Electives	80 credits minimum

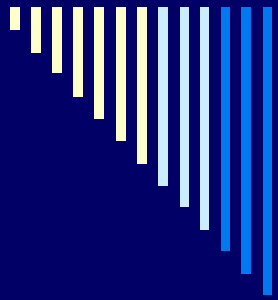

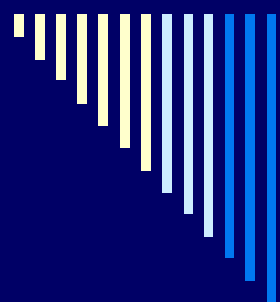




How to Succeed at BUHS

Freshman who want to receive their schedule before the first day of school must attend one day of Freshman Workshops.

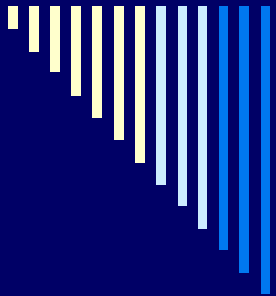
