
### Sample Freshman Schedule Class of 2014






# How to Succeed at BUHS






#### Walk - Around Registration


□ Pick up Registration Packets beginning August 10, 2011 in the Counseling Center

### Registration Process


- ·Complete Registration Forms

### Freshman Workshops


Freshman who want to receive their schedule before the first day of school must attend one day of Freshman Workshops.
